

Canoe Checklist

Packed?	Make sure it all fits in one not-too-large duffel bag. Keep a small bag handy for snacks, etc.
	Water - minimum 3 gallons for 2 days canoeing. Use plastic gallon jugs and label with name.
	Rope to tie duffel bag into canoe. 50 feet of 3mm climbing rope per person.
	Something to bail out the canoe with -- cup, sponge or make a bailer.
	Tent (Share with another scout/venturer)
	Sleeping pad (put in garbage bag)
	Sleeping bag (double-bag in two garbage bags)
	Stove (Share with another scout/venturer)
	Stove Fuel (Share with another scout/venturer)
	Matches / hot spark (put in plastic bag)
	Pot to heat water (Share with another scout/venturer)
	Bowl and/or cup
	Paper towels / handkerchief or bandana to wipe cup/bowl out with (plastic bag).
	Spoon and/or fork (plastic)
	Camera - bring a waterproof one or pack it in a dry (waterproof) bag or leave it at home
	Picture ID - you'll need this for Hoover Dam or other similar tours
	Food (each person): Put these in labeled gallon-size storage bags you can use later for trash.
	3 fast breakfasts -- granola bars, etc.
	3 lunches (i.e. tuna meal pack)
	1 dinners (i.e. backpacker entree)
	3-4 snacks (trail mix/jerky)
	Hot chocolate mix (3) optional
	Tang (3) optional
	Money for two-three meals on the road
	Plastic ziplocs (2-3) for garbage. (See above)
	Flashlight / headlamp with new batteries -- keep it in a dry bag.
	Clothes (put in garbage bag or bags)
	Waterproof jacket (pack or put over pack)
	Coat for under waterproof jacket (wear if cold)
	Waterproof pants (pack in case of really wet weather)
	Wear bicycling gloves
	Wear Quick-dry long-sleeve shirt (pack or put over pack)
	Wear quick-dry T-Shirt
	Wear zip-off pants
	Wear sunscreen!!
	Wear wide-brimmed hat (with chin strap) to protect your ears, neck and face on the water - IMPORTANT
	Wear Troop/Crew hat on the road for easy identification at rest stops - IMPORTANT
	Wear boating sandals / shoes
	Wear quick-dry socks and underwear
	Knit cap (pack)
	Socks, pack 2 pr.
	Underwear, pack 2 pr.
	Dry gloves
	Dry pants
	Dry shirt
	Dry sweater or coat
	Toothbrush
	Toothpaste
	Sunscreen
	Deet
	Knife / Leatherman
	Whistle
	Compass
	1st Aid Kit
	Neosporin
	Bring (or think of) one fun thing to do while away from base camp, i.e. Ghost stories, harmonica, string for string games, hacky sack.
